Subject to prescribed gender and age restrictions, there is no limit to the number of crews on which an individual may compete provided all crews are from the same club. Individuals may be a member of only one club (see DBC by-laws/membership).

Registration will open **March 1, 2010**. Contact the DBC office for assistance.

Closing date for entries is **June 10, 2010**.

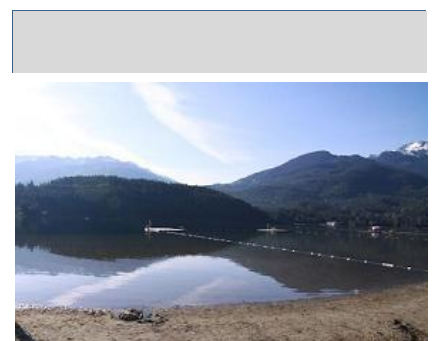
Entry Fees:
